

Welcome to this Minnesota TEFAP Food Shelf!

As of January 1, 2025

Due to a recent rule change from the USDA, you are <u>no longer required to</u> <u>provide your address</u> to receive food at TEFAP distribution sites (food shelves, meal programs, Tribal Nations).

What information do you need to provide to get food?

- Your name
- Number of children, adults, and seniors in your household
- Zip code (optional)
- Confirmation that your household income is at or below 300% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines

That's all the information/data that's needed to get food!

The following is **NOT** required:

- No Identification, No Proof of Address, No Proof of Income, No Proof of Household Size
- No Social Security Number, No Proof of Citizenship/Immigration Status
- No information other than what is on this form can be required from you to access food at this site.
- Additional information MAY be asked, but you are not required to provide it in order to get food.
