Purpose: MN Statute 142A.42 establishes the DIAPER DISTRIBUTION GRANT PROGRAM to provide diapers to under-resourced families statewide.

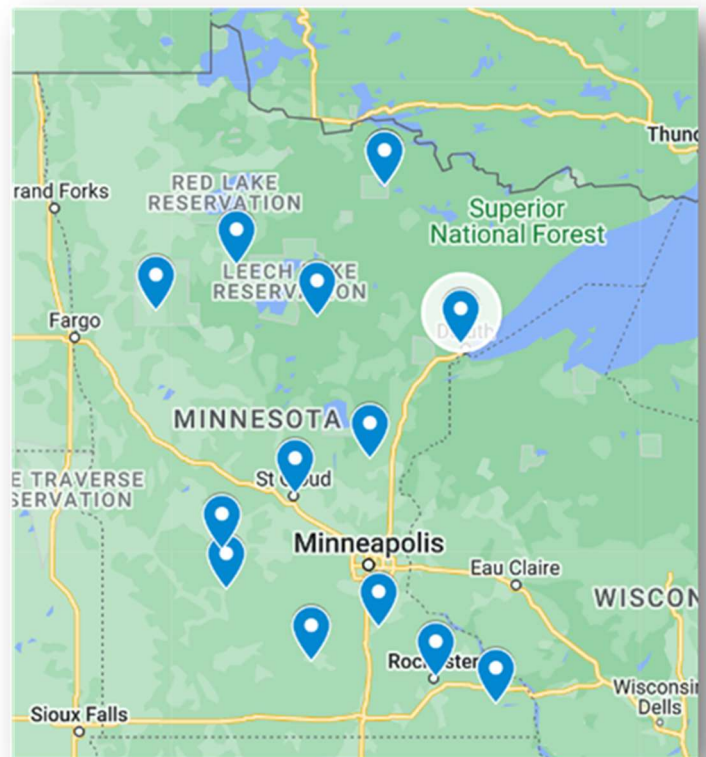
Description: This funding was approved by the Minnesota State legislature in FY 2023 as a grant to the Diaper Bank of Minnesota. A Request for Proposals will be issued in early 2025 for the next round of grant funds for SFY2026-27.

Funding: \$1.098M FY24-25, \$1.106M FY26-27

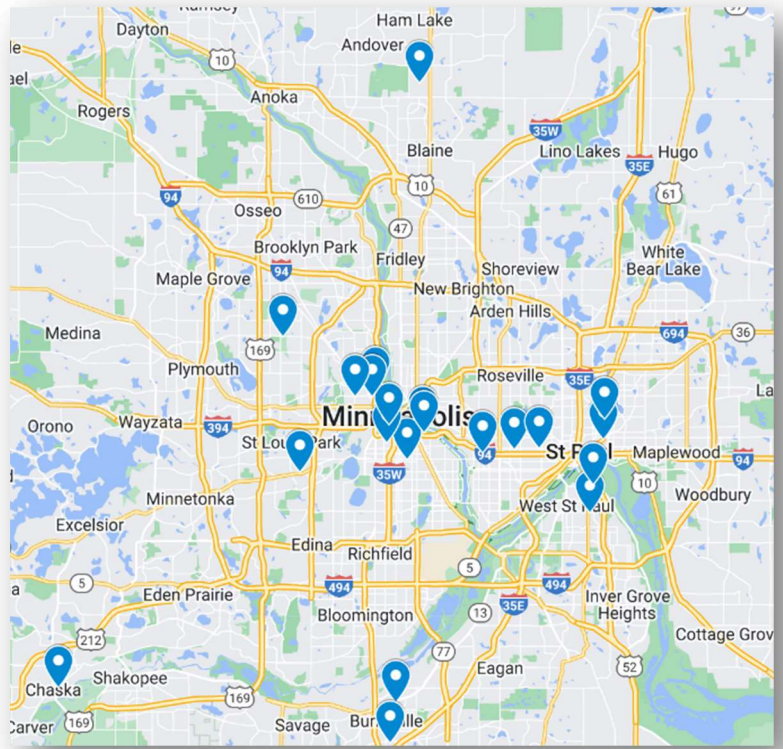
