

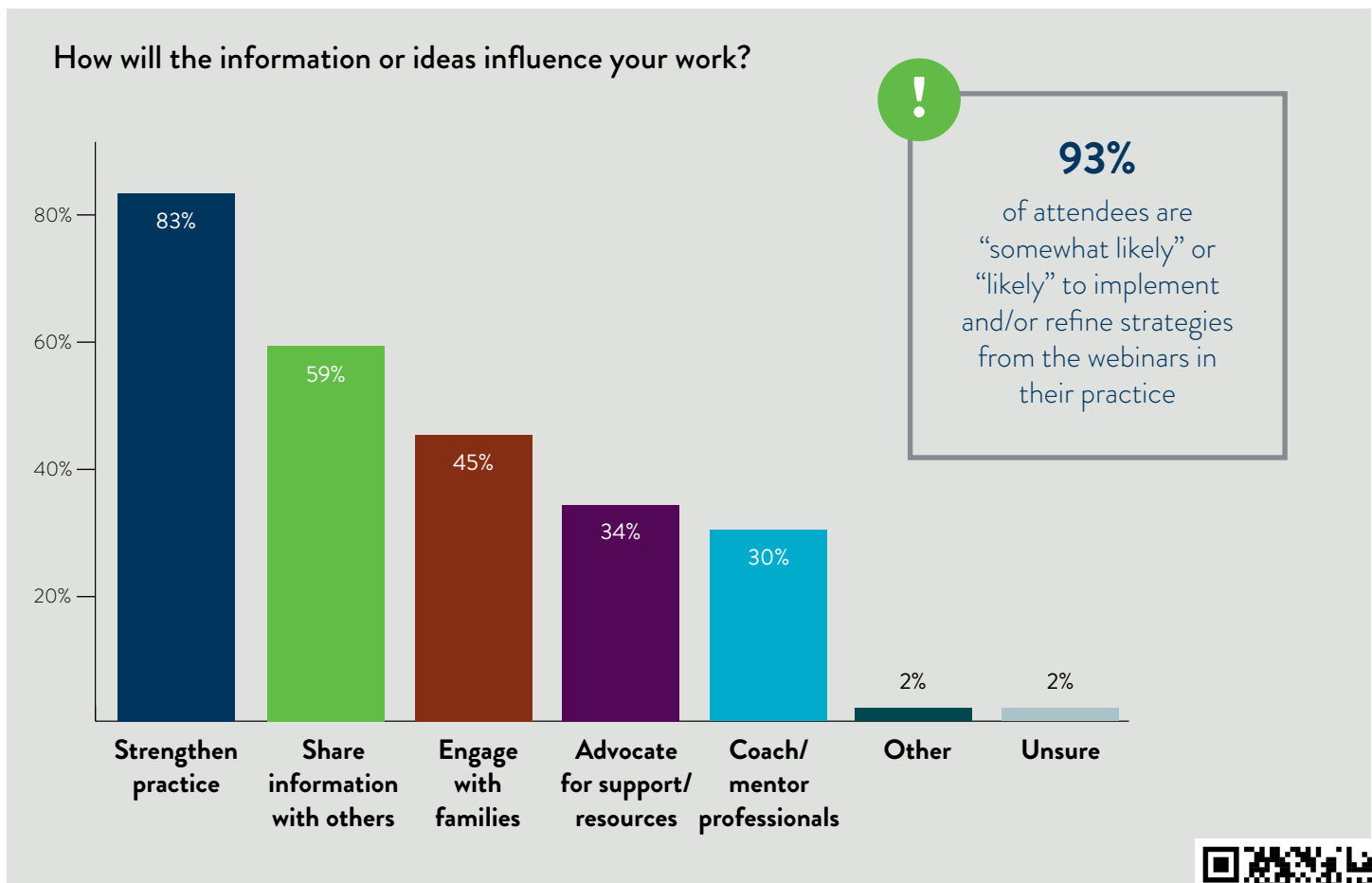
# Impact of Outdoor and Nature-Based Learning Webinars

- Exploring Nature as a Teacher for Physical Development

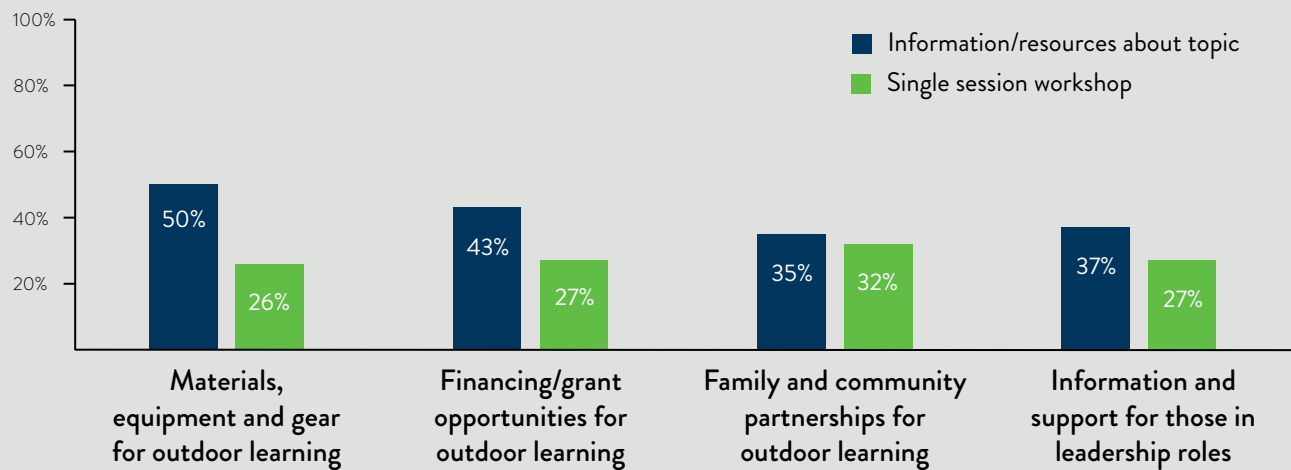
The Department of Children, Youth, and Families surveyed webinar attendees to learn more about the educators seeking out resources and analyze the effectiveness of the state's support.

## Attendees show a commitment to using what they learn.

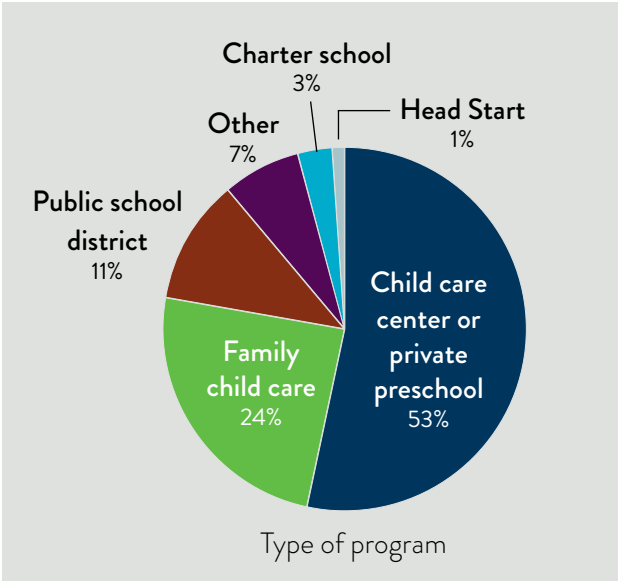


# Attendees want the state to provide more resources and professional learning opportunities.
