1. Public Early Care and Education

In which public early care and education programs did children participate prior to kindergarten? Insert the number or percent of children who participated in public Early Care and Education (ECE), Early Childhood Family Education (ECFE), Early Childhood Special Education (ECSE), and Minnesota District Preschool (District Pre-K).

2. Kindergarten Attendance

How do available early childhood experiences, such as early childhood screening and ECE participation, relate to kindergarten attendance? Other possible factors not yet reflected in ECLDS reports include chronic illness, health care access, housing insecurity, unreliable transportation, and parents with conflicting working schedules.

3. Financial Supports

Are kindergartners and their families receiving economic or food assistance? Participation data can be found for the Minnesota Family Investment Program (MFIP) /Diversionary Work Program (DWP), the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), the Child Care Assistance Program (CCAP), and the Free and Reduced-Price Meals (FRPM) program.

4. Mother Traits

What can you learn through ECLDS reports about moms of Minnesota kindergartners? Traits such as mother's high school (HS) education level and age are identified from birth records of public school kindergartners born in Minnesota.
